Teacher Eligibility

Teachers who are in good standing with OMTA & MTNA can enter students without having to pay a teacher entry fee. Each student may only enter once in either Division 1 or Division 2 per instrument, however, students may also enter into the ensemble division. Teachers who are not members of OMTA & MTNA can enter students into the event, but must pay a \$25 teacher enrollment fee.

Entry Divisions

SOLO DIVISIONS:

- Division 1 One Solo Division (\$25.00) one memorized piece or movement
- Division 2 Two Solos Division (\$40.00) two memorized pieces or movements
- Division 3 One Ensemble Division (\$25.00) one piece that only requires one piano for up to 6 <u>student</u> performers, memorization not required
- Division 4 Two Ensemble Division (\$40.00) two pieces that only requires one piano for up to 6 student performers, memorization is not required
- Division 5 One Solo Non-Memorized (\$25.00)

Piano Requirements

- 1. Age: PreK-12 Grade (over 18yrs please see Hobbyist Requirements)
- 2. Audition Days: Friday & Saturday
- 3. Please reference the OMTA Repertoire Requirements for OMTA District Auditions.
- 4. Photocopied music will not be acceptable.
- 5. 2 copies of music must be present for the Division 3, 4 and 5 (one for the judge, one for the performers).

Vocal Entry Requirements

- 1. Age: 7th-12th grade
- 2. Audition Day: Saturday AM
- 3. Please reference the OMTA Repertoire Requirements for OMTA District Auditions.
- 4. Musical Theatre Selections will also be allowed.
- 5. Repertoire written with accompaniment must be performed with an accompanist. Teachers may accompany their students. Recordings will not be permitted.

<u>Instrumental Entry Requirements</u>

- 1. Age: K-12
- 2. Audition Day: Friday after 3:00pm
- 3. Please reference the OMTA Repertoire Requirements for OMTA District Auditions.
- 4. Photocopied music will not be acceptable.
- 5. Repertoire written with accompaniment must be performed with an accompanist. Teachers may accompany their students. Recordings will not be permitted.

Hobbyist Entry Requirements (formerly known as Adult)

- 1. Age: 18 years or older, non-collegiate adult
- 2. Audition Day: Friday or Saturday
- 3. Please reference the OMTA Repertoire Requirements for OMTA District Auditions.
- 4. Photocopied music will not be acceptable.
- 5. Memory is optional for this entry please bring 2 non-photocopied copies of music if the entrant is playing with the music.
- 6. Repertoire written with accompaniment must be performed with an accompanist. Teachers may accompany their students. Recordings will not be permitted.

Ratings

- "100" The student's performance is at an exceptional level.
- "98-99" The student's performance is at a high level.
- "96-97" The student's performance is at an acceptable level.
- "92-95" The student's performance is below the acceptable level.

<u>Awards</u>

All students will receive a critique sheet and a festival ribbon. Students who score a_"100" will also receive \$10.00. (This check will be made out to and mailed to the teacher within a week of the event. The teacher is responsible for distributing the money to their student.)

<u>Judges</u>

The judges will be experienced adjudicators who are in good standing with OMTA and MTNA. The judges' decisions on all ratings will be final.

- List in succession and then use a bracket { to indicate family members, ensemble partners or students needing to car-pool.

- Time request changes will be accepted through email until noon on April 29, 2022.
